Summary of Site Work Completed in 2022 and Planned for 2023:

Work Completed in 2022: Obtained access from the current property owner of Non Owned Other Site - Calhoun Facility (also known as the Regency Gas property or Calhoun Gas Plant), implemented the LDEQ-approved Calhoun Gas Plant Site Source Area Site Investigation Work Plan (Work Plan), and prepared the draft Calhoun Gas Plant Site Source Area Site Investigation Report (Report) summarizing the field investigation findings. The Report will be submitted to LDEQ in January 2023. Developed a preliminary conceptual Site model (CSM) for both the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and the Calhoun Remediation Site. Participated in a site visit with LDEQ to discuss the source area investigation fieldwork and overall strategy for both the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and Calhoun Remediation Site. The purpose of the source area investigation is to characterize the nature and extent of the contamination emanating from the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and migrating downgradient onto the Calhoun Remediation Site. Supported preparation of Chapter 3.L (specific to the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and Calhoun Remediation Site) of the Multistate Trust 2021 Annual Progress Report. All costs to support the Calhoun Remediation Site are included in that site's 2022 ECA budget.

Work Planned for 2023: Finalize and submit to LDEQ the Calhoun Gas Plant Site Source Area Site Investigation Report (Report). Upon LDEQ's approval of the Report, prepare a Calhoun Gas Plant Site Source Area Site Investigation Work Plan Addendum (Work Plan Addendum) for the Report's recommended additional fieldwork to address data needs, and upon LDEQ approval of the Work Plan Addendum, implement the fieldwork and prepare the Calhoun Gas Plant Site Source Area Site Investigation Report Addendum (Report Addendum) summarizing the fieldwork findings. Update the preliminary CSM, integrating into the overall CSM for both the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and the Calhoun Remediation Site. Upon LDEQ approval of the Report Addendum, prepare a RECAP Evaluation Report in consideration of contamination at both the Calhoun Gas Plant Site and the Calhoun Remediation Site. Support preparation of the Multistate Trust's 2022 Annual Progress Report (portion specific to the Calhoun Gas Plant Site). All costs to support the Calhoun Remediation Site are included in that site's 2023 ECA budget.
