Summary of Site Work Completed in 2023 and Planned for 2024:

Work Completed in 2023: Performed WP-6 compliance monitoring and maintenance, Site mowing, and maintenance, including perimeter fence and Site building and equipment; Continued implementing the Groundwater Feasibility Study (FS) under the DEQ-approved Groundwater FS Work Plan. Performed routine surface water inspections and responded to sheen observations in accordance with sheen response plan (attached to Groundwater FS Work Plan). Prepared draft work plan for evaluation of surface soil at the City lot. Engaged with City leaders on access for offsite well sampling and initiated a meeting to introduce the Site and path forward as a basis for discussions on reuse/redevelopment ideas. Prepared Chapter 3.U (specific to the Site) of the Multistate Trust 2022 Annual Progress Report.

Work Planned for 2024: Perform WP-6 compliance monitoring and maintenance, Site mowing and maintenance, including perimeter fence and Site building and equipment. Continue implementing the Groundwater FS under the DEQ-approved Groundwater FS Work Plan (with transition from fieldwork, mostly complete in 2023, to data evaluation, hydrogeologic modeling, reporting, development of remedial action objectives [RAOs], and alternatives analysis). Support DEQ with the proposed plan and decision document. Perform routine surface water inspections and respond to sheen observations in accordance with sheen response plan. Perform community outreach, including with City leaders regarding future reuse ideas and opportunities. Prepare the Multistate Trust's 2023 Annual Progress Report (portion specific to the Site). Also, in light of ongoing sheen observations in the West Tributary, evaluate approaches for restarting LNAPL recovery as an interim action and prepare a work plan for DEQ review and approval.
