Summary of Site Work Completed in 2021 and Planned for 2022:

Work Completed in 2020: A Phase 1 Environmental Site Assessment was commissioned to determine the historical and regulatory uses of the Site.

Work Completed in 2021: No activities were performed in 2021.

Work Planned for 2022: Conduct a Phase 2 Environmental Site Investigation. The investigation will consist of the advancement of five soil borings using DPT method while collecting two soil samples from each boring. Each boring will then be converted to a temporary well to collect filtered and unfiltered groundwater samples from each well. All samples will be submitted to a licensed testing laboratory to test for VOCs, SVOCs, and RCRA metals. With the analytical results, a report will be prepared to document this work, which will then be provided to MDEQ for review and comments. The temporary wells will be abandoned.
