Work Completed in 2022: Worked with the site property owner to finalize the corrective action design strategy for the site, developed and submitted a Remedial Alternatives Analysis Memorandum and Corrective Action Design Report (CADR) to

IDNR. Conducted preconstruction contracting and permitting activities needed to implement the remedial construction (excavation) as detailed in the September 2022 CADR. The Multistate Trust worked with the site property owner and adjacent residential property owner to develop and execute property access agreements and property restoration plans, in preparation for the remedial construction activities.

Work Completed in 2023: Consistent with the IDNR approved CADR, developed engineering and design plans certified by a licensed State of lowa professional engineer for the remedial construction. Completed asbestos/ lead inspections and sampling for a portion of the on-site building, which will be removed as part of the remedial construction activities including permitting, subcontractor cost estimates and scheduling.
