Management has elected to omit substantially all the disclosures ordinarily included in financial statements prepared in accordance with the prescribed format basis of accounting. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the Trust's assets, liabilities, net trust assets, additions, and deductions. Accordingly, the financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.






