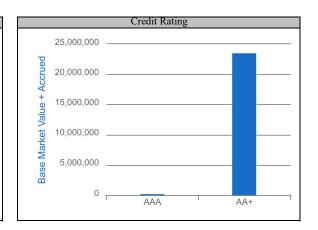

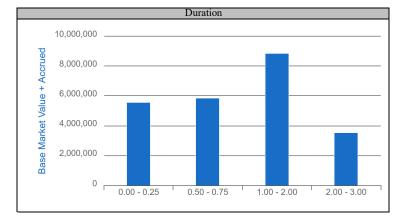

Base Exposure - Market Sector



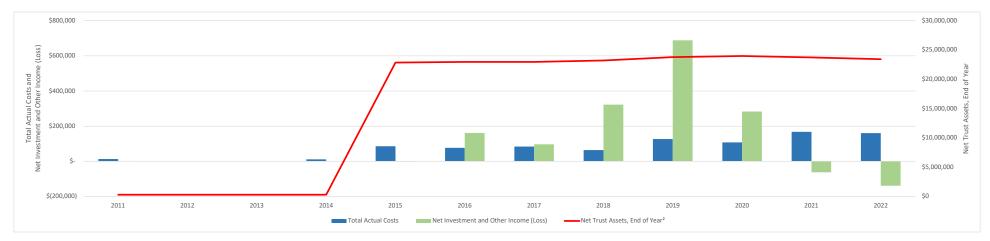
